NOTES FROM THE TEACHER



Today we started the evening with a fire drill.

All of the children received an angel sticker on the back of their name tags. They all behaved beautifully. Last week they all received an angel sticker because there was 100% attendance. Each week I choose a reason to earn one. Ask them what happens at the end of the year when there are many stickers on the backs of their name cards.

We read Chapter 2- We Believe In The Trinity, emphasizing that there is one God in three persons. Just as a tricycle is one bike with three wheels and a triangle is one shape with three angles, so is the Trinity one God in three persons. God the Father is the Creator and 1st Person of the Trinity. God the Son is the Savior (He died on the cross for us.) and the 2nd Person of the Holy Trinity, and God the Holy Spirit is the sanctifier (He strengthens us and makes us holy) and the 3rd Person of the Holy Trinity. To emphasize this concept each child had an apple slice. We talked about how the skin protects the apple just as God the father protects us. We eat the inside of the apple just as we eat the Body of Christ and the apple has seeds to grow just as the Holy Spirit spreads seeds of love and goodness in our hearts. Then we ate the apple. The Sign of the Cross and the Glory Be have the words of the Trinity in them.



HEAVENLY HOMEWORK:

Today we concentrated on the Trinity, tri meaning three." We read aloud Chapters 2 and 3. Please **study definitions #14-21 in the homework folder and do page 35 in the Faith First book.** Study the Sign of the Cross and the Glory Be. They make reference to the persons in the Trinity -Father, Son and Holy Spirit. Being that Oct. 2nd was the feast of our Guardian Angels, please learn the first line of our Angel of God prayer:

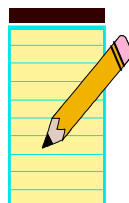
Angel of God my Guardian Dear
